Definitions

Synchronous Instruction shall be defined as a student or a group of students engaged in learning at the same time using technology that allows the teacher and student to connect in real-time to deliver:

- Timely actionable feedback to students
- Direct instruction to students through video conferencing
- Teacher guided peer-to-peer learning
- Whole or small-group instruction

Asynchronous Instruction shall be defined as:

- Learning done on students' own time or schedule
- Students work independently
- Self-guided instructional modules
- Pre-recorded lessons.
- Discussion, emails or chats that aren't happening in real time
